

HOW WE PRICE OUR PUPPIES

First of all I would like you to know that we are very serious about our dogs and our puppies. They are our children and we truly do love them very much. They come first and foremost in our lives. They get to play in the yard each day (weather providing), in the Summer they get to play in their swimming pool and play with their toys in the yard, or if they want, they can just lay in front of the fans on days that are not too hot... Everything they play with or sleep on or come in contact with is bleached or germicided each day. We try to keep their environment as clean as possible. We do not have any contagious diseases on our property, nor do we have a giardia or coccidia problem. We have some state-of-the-art equipment on premises such as: Littman stethoscopes (3), ThermoCare's ICU Unit, Nebulizing Therapy Units, VanGuard Centrifuge, 400X LOMO Microscope, Oxygen Equipment, as well as, all the appropriate medications needed to ensure our dogs/puppies health. We are in the process of purchasing our own Vet-Test which will allow us to do various blood tests. We are very serious about the health of our dogs. Before any dog can be brought into our home, they are tested for Brucellosis and Canine Herpesvirus. Once they arrive, they are isolated from all the other dogs, taken to the Vet for a complete thorough Vet Exam (checking for good bone structure) including bloodwork and fecal to ensure that the dog is healthy and is of good quality... Then we watch their personality to ensure they are going to be a good fit and are going to be something we are going to be proud of re-producing. They remain in isolation for a period of time until we deem it is safe for them to be integrated with the rest of our babies. As you can see, we take EVERY precaution to ensure you a healthy dog. We do not allow visitors at all. We cannot take the chance of someone carrying something on their clothes into our tiny babies. It's just too risky.

Overhead Costs Include: (Veterinary expenses, Organic dog food, bedding, playpens, heating pads for puppies, bowls/dishes, dental pet care items, toys, clothing, gloves, cleaning supplies, we go through a lot of baby food, receiving blankets, domed cat beds, medications, supplements, medical supplies, grooming expenses, micro-chipping, registration fees, marketing materials, website maintenance, housing and electrical, etc.)

Pricing is based on our overhead costs, type of puppy chosen, breed of puppy chosen, pedigree, and quality of puppy chosen. For instance, a puppy that is going to be two (2) pounds as an adult obviously requires a ton more care than a dog that is going to be four pounds or five pounds as an adult. For me to raise a puppy up that is going to be two pounds as an adult, we do not leave our home more than 4 hours at any given time. The teeny tiny puppies require care through the night, so I am up through night feeding, cleaning, and checking on puppies. The teeny tiny puppies have to be fed every 3-4 hours to ensure they do not go hypoglycemic. So, as you can see, they require a lot more time. The teeny tiny puppies have to stay longer than most puppies because we do not let them leave if they are acting finicky or are having any kind of “issues” at all. We will NOT ship any puppy until it reaches two pounds. ALL tiny puppies that will be two pounds as adults are hand delivered or must be picked up by the client. All puppies MUST be stable and ready to go for their new home or they do NOT leave the premises. We want you to be able to live your life once you receive your new baby, not be tied up with a sick puppy and all the Vet expenses that go along with that. This should be a very “positive” experience purchasing a puppy and we are aware of the impact a sick puppy can have on a home. We will NOT EVER let a puppy leave that is sick in any way, shape, or form. Food alone is a major expense as we supplement all Mothers with canned puppy food in addition to her organic dry food twice daily. All puppies are supplemented several times per day with canned dog food. We also go through a lot of baby food supplementing the “finicky” puppies in addition to their organic dry food so they don’t go hypoglycemic, plus we do use Nutri-Cal, but only minimally. We also will use good quality lunch meat and cheese to help supplement the puppies that are finicky. As you can see, it gets very expensive just to feed the puppies and get them to the point where they are being supplemented with canned food only and eating their dry. This is why we keep puppies so long...we want them “stable”. If you were to count up all the hours involved in these puppies from start to finish, their food, medical, overhead, all the other expenses, the parents, etc., you can see, we do not make that much money. The puppies are actually priced economically in accordance to our time and expenses. Puppies are a lot of work and take a lot of time. We LOVE our puppies and are very proud of them. We are very careful to screen each client carefully to ensure our puppies are going to loving families that will take great care of them and ensure our puppies a lifetime of happiness. In return, you too, will get a lifetime of happiness from your new healthy baby. We do think we have some of the best puppies you can find in regards to personality, quality,

health, and conformation. We are careful what we breed and to whom we breed. We are selective about our parents and select only parents that are warm, loving, outgoing, friendly, and will give you unconditional love at any given time.
